Level 2 Award Introduction to Youth Work Training

The award consists of four units which, if are completed creates the Award, or individual units can be accessed to meet need.

- Engaging and Communicating with Young People
- Safeguarding in a Youth Work Setting
- Theory of Youth Work
- Young People's Development

The award allows you to progress on to either the Level 2 Certificate in Youth Work (Youth Support Worker) or Level 3 Certificate in Youth Work. You will need to be in paid, unpaid or voluntary practice for a minimum of two hours per week to secure a place on the course. You will also be required to attend Bradford College one evening per week from 6pm to 9pm for a 10 week period.

Bradford Youth Service staff will have their fees paid by the Workforce Development Unit. Voluntary sector/Charities Course Fees -£450. Non voluntary Course Fees - £600.
