Expansion of North York Moors Young Ranger groups gets go ahead. The initiative, run by the North York Moors National Park Authority, has already proved popular among young people aged between 11 and 17, inspiring individuals to engage in the stunning surroundings of the National Park:
["We can help instil a passion for nature as well as developing new skills"](#)

West Yorkshire Police have warned that young people caught with flour or eggs over the Halloween period could face arrest. The warning was issued as part of a drive to reduce anti-social behaviour in the region this Halloween: ["Any young person found in possession of flour, eggs may be arrested."](#)

Almost 40 young people were referred to West Yorkshire Fire Service in the past year over concerns they were "high risk fire-setters." The service's Youth Intervention Team works with young people who are likely to get involved in dangerous behaviour in a bid to put them on the right path. As part of this work, they take referrals: [The team dealt with the 816 children and young people last year](#)

National News

Government announces £12m boost for youth sector. Youth projects are in line for an extra £12m in government funding to help address "urgent needs in the youth sector", Culture Secretary Nicky Morgan has announced:

[New Local Youth Partnerships also planned to be set up to "co-ordinate and sustain" local youth activities.](#)

"Vital new support for young people leaving care". Programmes totalling £19 million to improve support for care leavers have been announced. Access to better housing, healthcare and employment opportunities are at the core of a new multi-million pound settlement to improve the life chances of vulnerable young people leaving care: [There will also be 1,000 internships for care leavers over the next two years](#)

JK Rowling tells young people to stop volunteering at orphanages because it 'perpetuates child abuse'. She has urged young people to avoid volunteering at orphanages, claiming they do "irreparable harm" and "perpetuate the abuse" of children and communities:

["The system renders children vulnerable to abuse and trafficking, and impacts their life prospects"](#)

Government careers advice scheme will fail to reach thousands of young people, councils warn.

Students will struggle 'to make right choices' between academic and vocational routes:

Less than a quarter of Young People watched BBC News in the past year, Ofcom report finds.

Reports and Studies

Just 5% of young people feel listened to by politicians on Brexit, new survey reveals. The Jack Petchey Foundation spoke to more than 6,000 young people aged 11 to 25 - and found just 5% felt their views had been taken into account by politicians: [Brexit led to 72% of young people trusting politicians less](#)

Studies illustrate how marketing flavours may impact vaping habits among young people. Students who used "non-traditional flavours" such as fruit or sweets were more likely to still be vaping six months later and took more puffs: ["If flavours are taken away are they going to turn to using cigarettes?"](#)

Huge rise in pension saving recorded among young people. Automatic enrolment has seen a huge rise in the number of young people saving into a workplace pension in the UK, analysis by the Pensions Regulator has uncovered: [In addition, it was found that the gender gap has been significantly reduced](#)

Young people increasingly struggle to move out of insecure work. It is becoming harder for younger workers in insecure or temporary jobs to move into "good quality" permanent work, a report has claimed:
